## **RESOLUTION #17-01:**

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST TO ABANDON AND DEDICATE 240' OF NEWLY INSTALLED WATERLINE ALONG SPUR ROAD TO THE COUNTY OF MOORE PUBLIC UTILITIES.

**THAT WHEREAS**, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina allocated funds in fiscal year 2017 to construct a new 240'public water line in the right-of-way on the north side of Spur Road between Dundee Road and the Village of Pinehurst Public Services Facility, hereinafter referred to as the "water line"; and

**WHEREAS**, the water line has been duly constructed and tested in accordance with the standards of the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality and the County of Moore, N.C. Public Utilities; and

**WHEREAS,** the County of Moore, N.C. owns and operates all public water lines within the Village of Pinehurst, N.C. rights-of-ways; and

**WHEREAS,** the Village of Pinehurst, N.C. desires to covey ownership and operation of the water line to the County of Moore, N.C. Public Utilities; and

**WHEREAS,** The County of Moore, N.C. Public Utilities desires to accept ownership and operation of the water line;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in work session assembled this 10th of January, 2017 as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, hereby states its intention to convey the newly constructed water line on Spur Road to the County of Moore, North Carolina.

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor or her designee is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete the conveyance of the water line to the County of Moore.
