Co-chair Bart O'Connor called the meeting to order at 3:32 PM.

Minutes of May 14, 2012 meeting were unanimously approved. (Ginsey Fallon, called for the approval.....Lorraine Tweed seconded the motion).

Bart O'Connor introduced invited guests, Keith McDaniels, co-owner of Green Gate Olive Oils, and Chris Burrows, Pinehurst Resort's Ground Superintendent. Both are considering joining the Beautification Committee to replace recently resigned members, Vicki Binney and Sherry Mortensen.

Sub Committee Reports.

Gateways:

Andy Wilkison reported for the Committee. Four to six firms will be contacted to submit their qualifications for the purpose of designing "Gateways to Pinehurst", Way Finding signs and a Kiosk for downtown Pinehurst. Resume's will be reviewed by a Committee consisting of The Beautification Committee, Historical Commission, Appearance Committee, Revitalization Committee, along with Village Manager Andy Wilkison and Assistant Village Manager Jeff Batton. They will recommend one or more firms to the Village Council, who in turn, will select one to do the design work. It is hoped that the selection process and initial drawings by the contractor will be completed by year's end.

Triangles & Roundabouts:

Walter Morgan reported for the Committee. Maintenance continues on the various landscaping projects that Public Works and Beautification have created.

Flowers:

Bart O'Connor reported for the Committee. The long hot summer has forced the need for daily watering of hanging baskets, planters, and sign gardens. This in turn has increased the need for more ferilization. Bart expressed concern about the stress to flowers caused by this extremely hot summer.

Recent photos were shown to members, including the new flower plantings at the garden on Rt.#5, at Rt #211 and at Fields road at Rt #2.

2012 Christmas Events:

Lorraine Tweed, Natalie Dean and Martha O'Connor reported for the Committee.

After lengthy discussions, the following decisions were made:

- Select and install a blue spruce as Pinehust's Christmas tree, and select a Fraser Fir for next year.
 - For the first time, install double faced wreaths and bows on lamp posts, and 15 new slim Christmas trees with lights at five locations in the Village.
 - Hire Pinehurst Patio to install lights on the Blue Spruce and install slim Christmas trees.
 - Organize volunteers to assist Public Works personnel to hang lamp post wreaths.
 - With exception of Blue Spruce, install all Christmas decorations prior to Thanksgiving Day.
 - Organize volunteers to sell wreaths.
 - Develop publicity campaign to inform residents about events and wreath & bow fund raising effort.
 - Develop calendar identifying all critical dates pertinent to Christmas events.

Old Business:

Members were informed a DVD about beautification efforts was delivered to The Welcome Center.

New Business:

- It was agreed the Beautification Committee would participate at The Pinehurst Civic Group Expo, scheduled for September 13th at The Fair Barn. Member's are asked to volunteer their time to work the booth.
- Newly created plaques for the Welcome Center, Village Hall and for Ginsey Fallon were shown to members. Each 16"x20" frame summarized the ceremony held at The Welcome Center honoring former mayor George Lane, in whose name the center is now identified.
- Andy Wilkison reviewed with members a letter he had written to local DOT officials confirming our comments relating to future flower plantings at the large traffic circle. "The Village is desirous of the plantings in the islands of the traffic circle being established twice each year, once in the spring, and once in the fall".
