



Understanding the Long Range Comprehensive Plan:

- A <u>blueprint</u> for the Village's future that is laid out in the form of goals and strategies (e.g. actions to take)
- A <u>compass</u> that guides direction for local-decision making
- A <u>marketing tool</u> that articulates the vision and how the private sector can support that vision











Understanding the Long Range Comprehensive Plan:

### **Comprehensive Plan**

Policy document that guides:

- Land development
- Capital improvements
- Public programs

#### <u>Zoning</u>

Laws that govern:

- Permitted uses on properties
- Density of development
- Development design

Why should we have a Long Range Comprehensive Plan?


- Preserve the special character of Pinehurst
