

Village Council Summary of Meeting May 22, 2018 <u>www.vopnc.org/councilvideos</u>

- Carlton Cole, Fire Chief, recognized team members from the Pinehurst Fire Department and presented them with a certificate of commendation for four incidents in the past 12 months that resulted in reviving patients through Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and one (1) incident that resulted in two victims being rescued from the second floor of a burning home through a coordinated effort with Aberdeen Fire Department.

- Council approved an ordinance requesting the North Carolina Department of Transportation repeal the speed limit on Midland Road (NC2) for the portion designated.
- Council approved to authorize the Mayor or her designee to execute the contract with Van Camp, Meacham, & Newman, PLLC for legal services for FY 2019.
