



## **Village Council Summary of Meeting September 25, 2018**

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- Under the Consent Agenda, Council approved:
  - Public safety reports
  - Approval of draft Village Council meeting minutes.
    - September 11 Regular Meeting
    - September 11 Work Session
    - September 13 Emergency Meeting
- Moore County Commissioner, Lewis Gregory, informed Council of details regarding the upcoming ¼ cent sales tax referendum, which will be on the November ballot.
- Council held a public hearing to consider amending the Official Pinehurst Zoning Map as it pertains to the rezoning of one parcel of land located between 2040 & 2020 Midland Rd., adjacent to Walker Station and further identified as Moore County Parcel ID #00032232 and approval of the general concept plan.
- Council approved approve Ordinance 18-22 amending the Official Pinehurst Zoning Map as it pertains to the rezoning of Moore County Parcel ID #00032232 and the general concept plan, adding the condition that lots have to have one 5 foot setback and one 19 foot setback, such that no two 5 foot setbacks share a common lot boundary.
- Staff presented Council with the 2018 Community and Business Survey Results.
- Council approved the request for retiring police officer, Lt. Daryl Bender, to purchase his service revolver and be awarded his badge upon retirement.
- Council approved Ordinance 18-21 accepting Power Plant Rd., right-of-way, sidewalk, on street parking and storm water pipes as a public street and right-of-way of the Village of Pinehurst.
- Council approved Resolution 18-22 amending the fees and charges schedule to add Fair Barn lawn rentals.
- Under the Work Session, Council discussed:
  - Progress of the 5-day Planapalooza Event for the Envision the Village Long Range Comprehensive Plan that occurred between September 19th and 24<sup>th</sup>.
