## Our Team:

The Police Chief reports directly to the Village Manager and serves as a member of the senior leadership team. In addition to the Chief, the Police Department consists of 24 sworn police officers, four dispatchers, one administrative coordinator and six reserve auxiliary officers to protect the life and property of approximately 16,452 residents.

The Police Department is comprised of two Bureaus; the Operations Bureau and the Support Bureau.

The Operations Bureau consists of 4 Patrol Platoons, a Traffic Safety Team and an IMPACT Team.

The Support Bureau consists of the Investigations Division and the Administration Division. In addition the department staffs an Emergency Response Tactical Team that reports directly to the office of the Chief of Police.
