<u>Pinehurst 4th of July Parade Guidelines</u>

Route

- Lineup will take place on Magnolia Road near the Pinehurst Village Hall at 395 Magnolia Rd.. Parade begins at the intersection of McCaskill Road and Magnolia Road toward the Village Center, taking a Left on Dogwood, Right on Market Square, Left on Magnolia Road and Left on Chinquapin. Parade ends just after passing the Holly Inn.
- We will be providing water stops for our many four legged parade entries along the route.

Check-in/Line up

- Line up begins at 8:30 AM on Magnolia Rd.
- All parade participants must arrive and check-in by 9:30 AM

Walkers

• If you are walking in the parade, you may park your vehicle in the parking lot behind the Village Hall (Enter lot from Rassie Wicker Drive)

Safety

- To avoid the risk of possible injury, the throwing of candy or any other item from a vehicle or float is strictly prohibited. Any items you wish to distribute to the crowd **MUST** be handed out from someone walking alongside your entry. We do not want any children running into the streets in front of cars.
- Any items being distributed must only be passed out while walking in your assigned parade spot. No items should be passed out before the start of the parade or following the conclusion of the parade. At no time should items be passed out in Tufts Memorial Park, this is prohibited.
- Entries with children under the age of 18 must also have parents or other adult chaperones riding and or walking alongside who provide supervision.

Flow of the Line of March

• Keep up with the unit in front of you at all times. Stops for performances will only be allowed in front of the stage/judges stand.

Animals

• Entries involving animals of any kind must provide their own clean-up, or "pooper scooper".
